The Toledo Naturalists' Association has established a small grants program to support student research that will significantly increase our knowledge, or aid in the preservation, of native plants or wildlife in northwest Ohio. The award is named in honor of the late Harold F. Mayfield, a life-long TNA member and internationally-renowned ornithologist. Each year TNA may award a grant of \$2,000 under this program.

**An application must include all of the following:**

Your name, mailing address, phone, and email address

Your resume

Letter of support from a faculty sponsor

Amount requested (not to exceed \$2,000)

Brief budget

Project title

Need for the proposed research

Concise description of the procedures

Applications will be accepted continuously; the awards committee will announce its decision within a month of receipt of an application.

Award winners will be expected to report on the outcome of their research project at one of the monthly TNA meetings following completion of their project.
